

His novel, THE GRANDMASTER, was awarded 2007 Best Science Fiction Novel by the Hollywood and New England Book Festivals. The title piece of his story collection, IN OUR HOUSE: TANTALIZING TALES OF TERROR, was nominated for the Pushcart Prize for fiction, and three stories from that collection were performed at The New Short Fiction Series in Hollywood. His gothic horror story, CHAMBER MUSIC, was awarded 2012 Best Short Story by the Electronic Publishing Industry Coalition.
